- Noelle Schnacky is a nationally recognized youth leader, nonprofit founder, and author who is making waves in congenital heart defect (CHD) advocacy. As Miss America Organization's, Miss Florida's Teen 2025, the founder and president of Hope for Heart Kids 501(c)(3), and a lobbyist for CHD research funding, Noelle has dedicated her platform to raising awareness, supporting families, and championing legislative funding to fight the most common birth defect in America.
- Her organization, Hope for Heart Kids, was founded in memory of her cousin Tyler, who lost his battle with CHD at age 15. Through her work, she has successfully donated her Hope for Heart Kids children's books to hospitals across the country, raised funds for the UF Congenital Heart Center and Give Kids the World Village, and continues to advocate as a Youth Ambassador for the American Heart Association for legislation that will increase CHD research funding.
- Beyond her nonprofit, Noelle was recognized as a "40 Under 40" honoree by *Central Florida Style Magazine*, a testament to her leadership and impact at a young age. With a cumulative following of 400K and monthly impressions averaging 5 million, she was Grammy-nominated (2025), was Varsity Cheer Captain at her high school, and is a 15-year competitive dancer. She believes that faith, perseverance, and purpose-driven leadership can create lasting change—and she's proving it every day.
